





FIRE: 2018 Camp Fire in California

Our changing climate is shifting the nature of wildfires. As the deadly mega-fire that destroyed 90% of homes in Paradise, California demonstrated, wildfires are now more frequent, burn more intensely, and increasingly impact populated areas. Landsat gives fire managers spatial data to help them protect people. Landsat data is used to create vegetation and fuel maps, as well as the burn severity and size metrics that inform post-fire remediation and allow tracking of fire behavior trends.
