Whether imaging landslides, wildfires, floods or volcanic eruptions, Landsat can help first responders and disaster management teams plan effective strategies to deal with natural disasters. This false-color Landsat image shows flooding in Pakistan on August 28, 2020. The image combine shortwave infrared, near infrared, and red light (bands 6-5-4) to better distinguish flood waters beyond their natural channels.
